The Garland Fire Department is now offering Fire Academy and EMS training courses. All classes will be taught by TCFP Certified Instructors and will meet or exceed the recommended curriculum hours suggested by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection.

Our goal is to train and prepare young professionals for a career as Firefighters and Emergency Medical Technicians. Our exciting course activities include:

- Classroom Instruction
- Physical Training
- Team Building
- Hands-on Training
- Practical Skills
- Live Fire Training

Fire Training is 17 weeks (648 hours) *January 10 to May 6* with a maximum of 24 students per class. EMT will be 6 to 7 weeks (200+ hrs) continued after fire training.
